Blair Landscape was incorporated 4 years ago. Then, in 2004 Randy decided to partner with Michael Kobold. The newly formed partnership was K & B Landscape Services, Inc. He went from having 12 to now 50 employees including 2 full-time landscape design architects, and the business is continuing to grow. The partnership, where Michael has a business and construction background and Randy has a business and horticulture background, seems to be a very good match. Randy is in charge of the maintenance division and special projects (projects under \$15,000).

K & B Landscape Services is located in San Ramon and does projects and maintenance from Livermore to Castro Valley and Fremont to Martinez, but will go farther for commercial jobs. The minimum maintenance job is \$260.00 per month, with jobs ranging up to \$250,000 and more.

They are considered a one-stop shop and can do anything from soil prep, plant demolition and installation, irrigation, pest and weed control to concrete, retaining walls, wood structures, ponds, etc. The only thing they don't do is install swimming pools.
